All Weather Windows Attic Hatch Installation

- 1. Prepare rough opening between 24" on center roof trusses, 22.5" x 30.25" inside dimensions. (Fig. 1)
- Remove insulated panel from attic hatch frame and put aside.
- 3. Install frame into rough opening and tack in place with screws or nails through the nail fin.
- 4. Measure corner to corner to ensure the frame is square (+/-1/8"). Use a level to make sure frame is not twisted in the opening (one corner lower than the rest). Adjust as necessary.



- 5. Frame must be fastened with eight #8 x 2" pan head screws in predrilled holes through the frame. Use shims at screw locations to prevent the screws from bowing the frame. (Fig. 2 and 3)
- 6. Clean weatherstrip of any debris. Lift insulated panel sideways through frame opening into attic, rotate flat and set in place.
- Ensure panel is seated and sealed against the weatherstrip and the latches operate properly to avoid condensation buildup.
- Securely seal vapor barrier to the nail fin to avoid condensation buildup in the attic. (Fig. 3)
- 9. Install drywall and casing as shown in Fig. 3.
- 10. The bottom face of insulated panel can be painted but it is not required. Do not paint the latches or weatherstrip!


